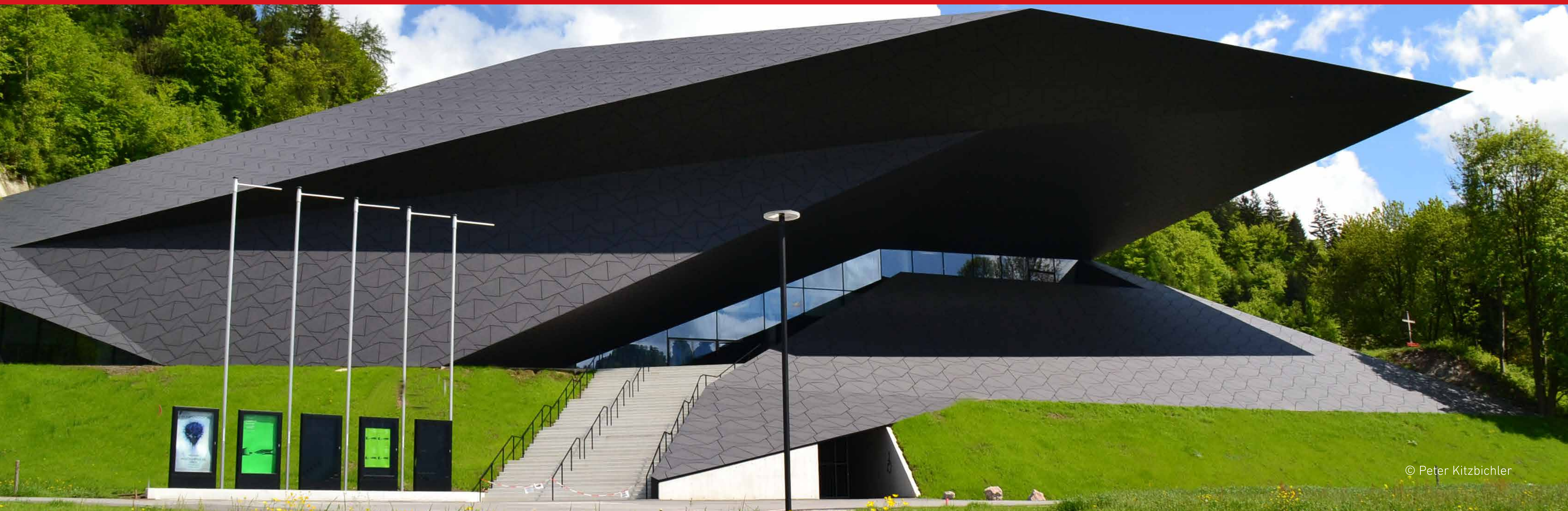


OBJECT OF THE MONTH



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FESTIVAL HALL, ERL

The new Tyrolean Festival Hall was designed by the Vienna offices of Delugan Meissl Associated Architects. The designers created a striking black and white façade, presenting a bold yet modest character adjacent to the summer-only passion play complex.

The steep gallery offers up to 862-strong audiences an outstanding overall view of the globally largest orchestra pit and the 450 square metre stage.

This ultra-modern festival complex has been technically enhanced ever since completion. This included a state-of-the-art PICHLER ventilation system: quiet, energy-efficient, environmentally responsible and easy to operate.

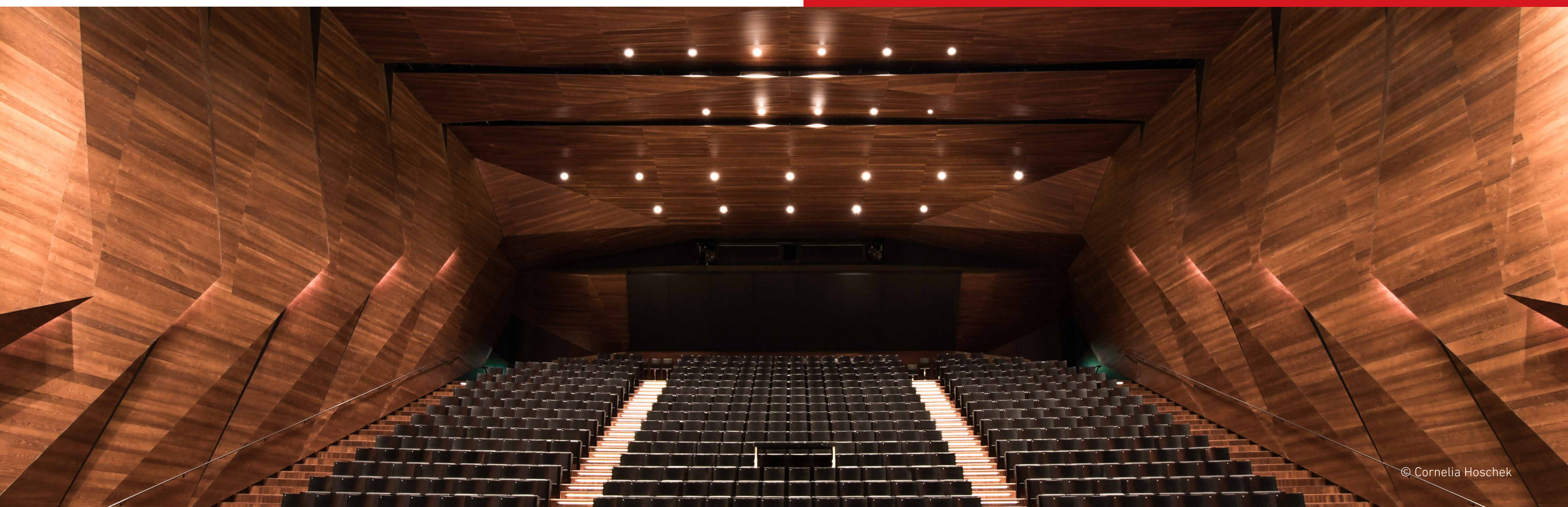
