At the peak of Gaislachkogel, visitors can discover a one-of-a-kind highlight made to measure for film enthusiasts. Unique in the world: Where Daniel Craig was in front of the camera for Spectre, a brand new James Bond Installation takes you on a journey to the cinematic universe of the planet's most famous secret agent. In nine halls and chambers inside the mountain, covering 1300 m², and a huge 230 m² outdoor plaza 007 ELEMENTS presents a captivating composition.

The architectural masterpiece was designed by the Tirolean architect Johann Obermoser. After projecting the stations of Gaislachkogel mountain gondola and the ice Q restaurant, he also created 007 ELEMENTS, a masterpiece when it comes to museum-touristic presentation. The ambience with its sober and to the utmost reduced rooms was inspired by the formal idiom of the legendary Bond designer Ken Adam.

At 3048 m above sea level, PICHLER ventilation units supply the Museum with permafrost soil with fresh air.
